- ❖ **National Newspapers:** National Newspapers Core includes abstracting, indexing, and comprehensive full text for The Christian Science Monitor, The Los Angeles Times, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, and The Washington Post. You can find the information you need quickly because of the database's detailed indexing. Includes 18 Washington State newspapers.
