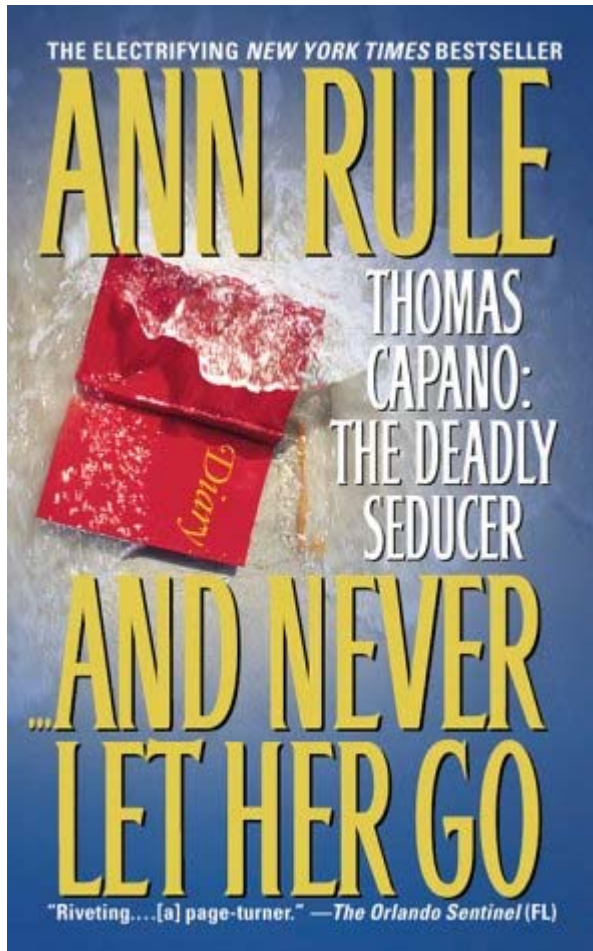


...And Never Let Her Go
