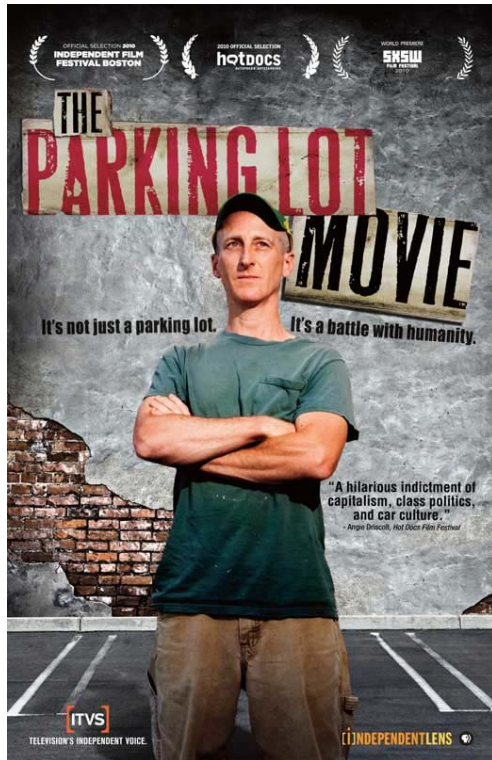


## The Parking Lot Movie
