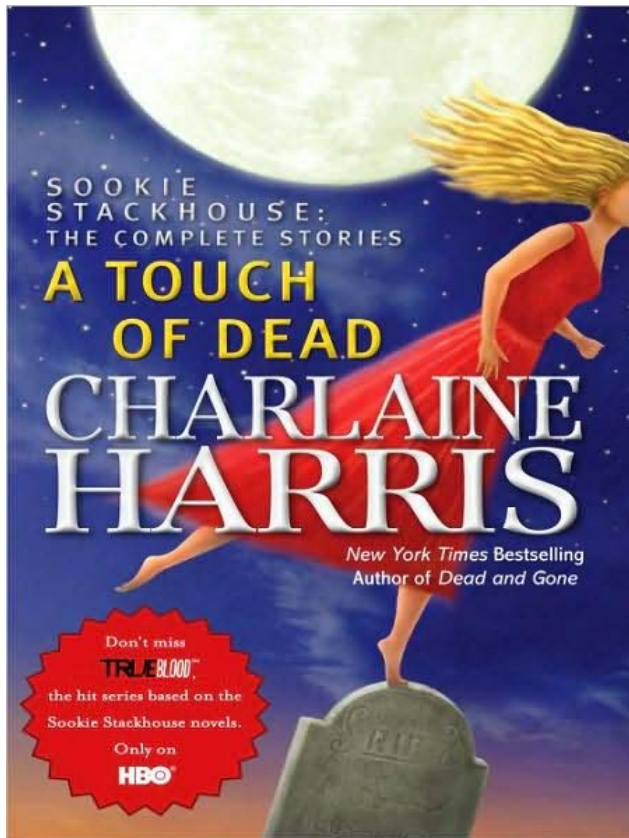


# Sookie Stackhouse: The Complete Stories
